<b>**Oxford Houses</b> Several locations in Austin; 512-659-5845	Transitional housing for men & women (separate) recovering from alcohol or drug addiction. Homes are democratically run, members are responsible for expenses, no drugs or alcohol is allowed. Accepts ex-offenders.

Cesar Chavez Street; 512-236-9629 or 512-478-3653	Transitional housing (90 days maximum stay) and support services for homeless men with alcohol and other substance abuse dependency. Must be clean and sober at intake; program does not offer detox. Laundry facilities within walking distance, kitchen facilities, use of telephones. \$62.50/week or \$67/week with meals.

Each room is equipped with a bed, chest of drawers, microwave, refrigerator, linens, and cable TV. On site amenities: clothing closet, food pantry, security, computer/ Internet, day room, soda/snack machines, free coffee, covered parking, coin laundry, recreational activities, discounted phone cards, and community kitchens. Rent is \$130 per week; all bills paid; \$100 deposit.
